### What did we tell you in Sept. 2005



Long Term

The long-term objective for Eclipse RCP is for it to be considered as one of the top 3 platforms for building client and server applications by ISVs and internal enterprise applications. It is expected that the other two frameworks will be Microsoft .Net and a framework to support rich internet browser based applications (RIA).

- Focus for next 12 months
  - ISV Recruitment and Adoption
  - Developer Evangelism
  - Service and Education Providers

### What did we tell you in Sept. 2005: Opportunity Knocks eclipse

- MS Vista will cause ISVs to retool
- Linux is pushing into the desktop
- Web services / Web 2.0 is causing ISVs and Enterprises to rethink their client strategy
  - Browser vs rich client

#### What has happened since?



- RCP Awareness and Adoption is growing
  - Evans Data August 2006 shows
    - 22% have adopted RCP (130% increase from previous year)
    - 44% plan on increasing their use of RCP within six months
  - 34% of EclipseCon attendees *using* RCP (30% in 2006)
  - Counterpoint: SD Times survey showed no increase between 2005 and 2006
- IT Industry Trends
  - AJAX/RIA has significant momentum and visibility
  - Adobe very aggressive with Flash and Apollo
  - Vista has been released
  - IBM, BEA and others basing their middleware stacks on OSGi/Equinox
  - Sprint demanding OSGi compliance in next-gen mobile handsets

## Update on ISV Recruitment and Adoption



- Limited success in signing up major companies to promote RCP
  - Reached out to Adobe, SAP, Business Objects, Red Hat, Novell, Apple, BEA, HP, IBM Intel, AMD
  - Exception being IBM
  - Lots of tactical usage --- most of these companies are using RCP, but not interested in investing in promotion
- IBM Lotus ships major new product line based on RCP
  - Sametime, Notes (Hannover)
- Steady stream of case studies
  - Adobe, Band XI, JP Morgan, Nuology, RPC, APC, Momentum, Swiss Rail, BEA, Intuit

## Update on Developer Evangelism



- ✓ Recruit open source projects that enhance and extend RCP
  - ✓ BIRT, OHF, Higgins, ECF, RAP, EMF, GMF, etc.
- ✓ Encourage Eclipse Portals to publish Eclipse RCP content
  - ✓ EclipseZone recently published an OSGi series
- ✓ Eclipse Evangelist will focus on RCP
  - ✓ RCP presentations at conferences and webinars
- ✓ Encourage commercial Eclipse RCP RAD Tools
  - ✓ Instantiations RCP Developer, Borland CodeGrear, MyEclipse
- ✓ Case studies
  - ✓ Lots.
- ✓ Promote new Eclipse RCP book
  - ✓ Gave away book to EclipseCon registrants and Javapolis
  - ✓ Approx 10K books printed
- ✓ RCP Webinar series
  - ✓ 3 webinars; 2100 attendees

# Update on Service and Education Providers



- Lesser priority was put on recruiting service and education providers
  - Needed to build demand
- EPIC is developer a service and training directory to help promote RCP providers.

- Focus more on Equinox & OSGi
  - R\*P --- it's not just about the client anymore
- Continued to focus on
  - Developer evangelism
  - ISV recruitment
  - Recruit a 'killer app' to drive adoption
  - Enabling service and education providers
