#### Issues

- Combinations with incompatible licenses
- Interaction with standards organizations
- Collaboration with other open source communities
- Delivery of complete functional sets
- Competition

### Examples

- EclipseLink and the JCP interaction
- DSDP in their monitoring infrastructure
- Equinox and the intereaction with OSGi and Apache
- CDT delivering a complete stack
  - May not be addressed by dual licensing
- NASA has patent related issues
- Glassfish could not adopt Equinox
- OSGi EE reference implementation and Apache
