2000+ Friends of Eclipse as of today!

What's the problem?

Problem



We can do better than the status quo!

- Earmark FoE money for committer-friendly activities
- Do this in a more transparent fashion

Proposal



Expand the FoE program to include:

- event funds (e.g., meetups, EclipseDays)
- travel funds (e.g., conferences)
- marketing stuffs (e.g., shirts, stickers)
- individual Eclipse.org project needs

Create a bugzilla category for funding proposals

Model policy after other open source organizations

- Fedora
