Processing

- Synthesized inputs into themes
- Add-in provider input weighted proportional to representation at Eclipse board of directors
- Relentless refinement and re-factoring through active participation of Requirements Council







Output

- Strategic member companies, Eclipse projects, and general member companies on the same page
- Folks involved with Eclipse for 3-4 years agreed that the themes "made sense"
- Themes guide architecture, planning, resource allocation
 - Scaling Up theme used to focus on performance improvement
